Accidental shooting kills Springfield teen

SPRINGFIELD (AP) A 13-year-old Springfield boy was fatally shot in the head as he and a friend played with a shotgun, police said.


The death of Hayes Norbury remained under investigation yesterday, Springfield police Officer Gina Wolf said. An autopsy showed the boy died of a single shot to the forehead area with a .410-gauge shotgun.

The incident happened about 2:30 p.m. Wednesday while Norbury was visiting the home of a 13-year-old friend, Wolf said.

There was no adult supervision at the time. The boy who lived at the home called his mother at work after the shooting, Wolf said.


